Genesis 5

Verses 1-2

This is the book of the generations of Adam. On the day when God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. ² He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them "mankind" on the day when they were created.

This is the book of the generations of Adam.

This is the 2nd section of the 10 sections of the Book of Genesis. The first section was in Genesis 2:4.

God wanted mankind to know the history of the world and this list of the descendants of Adam are crucial to man's understanding of when creation and other major events in world history took place. The bible is more than a book about religion; it is also a book of history. From Genesis to Nehemiah we have a progressive account of the events that took place from creation until the Jews returned to Jerusalem after the Babylonian captivity. This was a period of about 5,000 years. Just as a reminder, this is about 1,365 more years than what "creationists" commonly suggest. This will be explained at the end of this chapter.

Verses 3 - 5

³When Adam had lived 130 years, <u>he fathered a son in his own likeness</u>, according to his image, and named him Seth. ⁴Then the days of Adam after he fathered Seth were eight hundred years, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ⁵So all the days that Adam lived were 930 years, and he died.

He fathered *a son* in his own likeness, according to his image, and named him Seth.


Adam, Abel and Seth were all believers in the Lord. This chapter is a list of sons that were believers.

One important this to notice is how long Adam and his "sons" were living at this time. The word for "sons" here is in the biblical sense which means consecutive generations of Adam. We would use the terms son, grandson, great-grandson etc.

- ⁶ Now Seth lived 105 years, and fathered Enosh. ⁷ Then Seth lived 807 years after he fathered Enosh, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ⁸ So all the days of Seth were 912 years, and he died.
- ⁹ Now Enosh lived ninety years, and fathered Kenan. ¹⁰ Then Enosh lived 815 years after he fathered Kenan, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ¹¹ So all the days of Enosh were 905 years, and he died.
- ¹² Now Kenan lived seventy years, and fathered Mahalalel. ¹³ Then Kenan lived 840 years after he fathered Mahalalel, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ¹⁴ So all the days of Kenan were 910 years, and he died.
- ¹⁵ Now Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and fathered Jared. ¹⁶ Then Mahalalel lived 830 years after he fathered Jared, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ¹⁷ So all the days of Mahalalel were 895 years, and he died.
- ¹⁸ Now Jared lived 162 years, and fathered Enoch. ¹⁹ Then Jared lived eight hundred years after he fathered Enoch, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ²⁰ So all the days of Jared were 962 years, and he died.
- ²¹ Now Enoch lived sixty-five years, and fathered Methuselah. ²² Then Enoch walked with God three hundred years after he fathered Methuselah, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ²³ So all the days of Enoch were 365 years. ²⁴ Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.
- ²⁵ Now Methuselah lived 187 years, and fathered Lamech. ²⁶ Then Methuselah lived 782 years after he fathered Lamech, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ²⁷ So all the days of Methuselah were 969 years, and he died.
- ²⁸ Now Lamech lived 182 years, and fathered a son. ²⁹ And he named him Noah, saying, "This one will give us comfort from our work and from the hard labor of our hands *caused* by the ground which the Lord has cursed." ³⁰ Then Lamech lived 595 years after he fathered Noah, and he fathered *other* sons and daughters. ³¹ So all the days of Lamech were 777 years, and he died.
- ³² Now after Noah was five hundred years old, Noah fathered Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

This pattern of giving the age of a patriarch when one of his sons was born and the total number of years the patriarch lived is of great importance. Since the generations overlap we can construct a history of mankind.

Since there is overlap between each person we can be sure that there are no missing years in this chronology. Because of this:

- 1. We know the age of the world and the universe.
- 2. We know when the global flood occurred.
- 3. And it establishes the dates of other major events in the bible.

There is no doubt there were many other children born to each of these patriarchs since they were living for 900 plus years before the flood. But only those who were believers and heads of the family line are recorded. They were not perfect but they stood above their fellow brothers in faith and character.

Verse 24

Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

This phrase takes us back to the Garden of Eden when Adam & Eve had not sinned yet and their relationship with God was of unbroken fellowship. This is not meant to say that Enoch was without sin but to emphasis the close relationship he had with God.

We know that Enoch did not experience physical death.

See Hebrews 11:5

⁵ By faith Enoch was taken up so that <u>he would not see death</u>; and he was not found because God took him up; for before he was taken up, he was attested to have been pleasing to God.

This was an early indication that God had power over death, that God can forgive sins, and that this life on earth is not the end of life for mankind.

Verse 29

And he named him Noah, saying, "This one will give us comfort from our work and from the hard labor of our hands caused by the ground which the Lord has cursed."

The cursing of the ground in Genesis 3 made life more difficult for all of mankind but how did Noah comfort mankind in his work?

We know the world of that time (the pre-flood world) went through a great cleansing by water and that many new layers of dirt were formed during the flood. Could it be that the productivity of the land today, while not perfect, is much better than it was prior to the flood?

Verse 32

³² Now after Noah was five hundred years old, Noah fathered Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Shem stands ahead of his brothers in this list, but he was not the oldest. He received this honor because he was a believer. In Genesis 11we find out that Shem was 100 years old, two years after the flood.

See Genesis 11:10

These are *the records of* the generations of Shem. Shem was a hundred years old when he fathered Arpachshad, two years after the flood;

So Shem must have been 97 at the beginning of the flood and 98 at the end of the flood.

Concerning the dates in my charts

The dates that I use from Adam to Nahor **do not match** those that most creationists use. This is because I use the dates given in the Septuagint while they use the dates given in the Masoretic text. The following videos do a good job of explaining this issue.

From Adam to Enoch the only difference between the two accounts is the age when they had their son. However, from Arphaxad to Nahor there is an additional difference in the number of years that they lived.
